## Season in Review

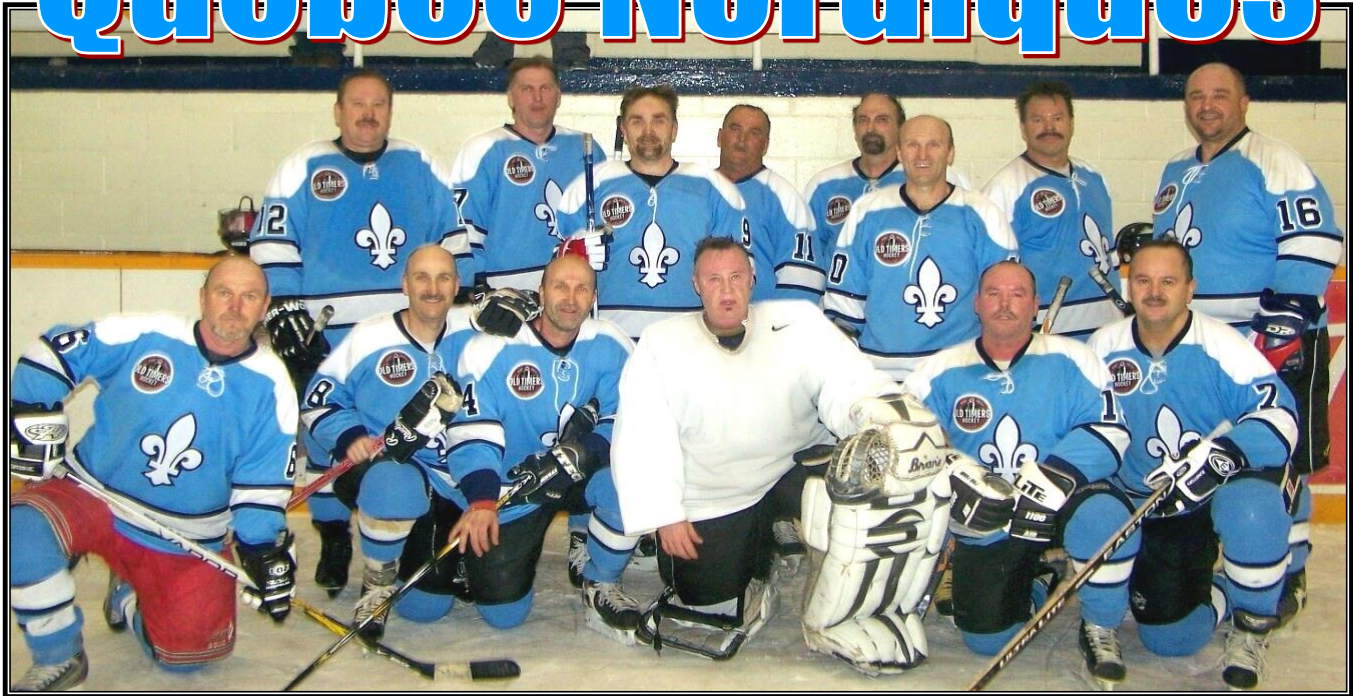

# How it all began...

The League started 22 years ago by Tom Murphy. You can find Tom in either the Erin Mills arena or Port Credit arena operating the skate sharpening shops at both locations. There are only 3 active players that have been in the league for all of the 22 seasons. Hanson, McDonald and Trauzzi. McDonald actually was on the first Championship team back in 1987. Another 14 current members have been playing for 15+ years. The City affiliated group runs as a non profit organization and has sponsored local Port Credit Hockey youth hockey teams and have donated sweaters to local charities. Following our Championship Night the League has a golf tournament and a Dinner, Dance and Awards night. The turn over is quite small each year and a healthy waiting list to get in. A special thank you to Tom Murphy and all of the past members that have played in the Port Credit Oldtimers League. And a special thank you to all of the current 75 members, may you all enjoy another successful 20 years of league play.

# Oldtimers enjoy good times on ice

In many ways, however, time has stood still for original members of the Port Credit Oldtimers' Hockey League.

On May 5, the league concluded its 20th season, with gold and bronze medal games at Port Credit Memorial Arena.

What started as an over-35 league 20 years ago is now reserved for players over age 42, with an average age of 48. The league also includes a couple of feisty 60-year-olds and a few grandfathers.

McDonald, who remembers his Mean Machine overcoming a 3-1 deficit with three minutes to play to win the league's inaugural title contest, 4-3, rarely misses a game.

"Each season, I'll miss one game (due) to other commitments," he said.

What about weddings?

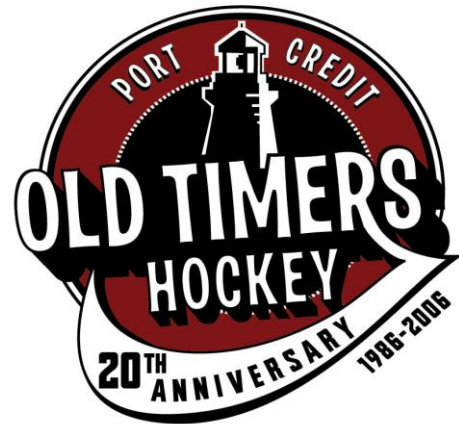
"If it's family, I've got to go. If it's a friend, I'll have to weigh the situation."

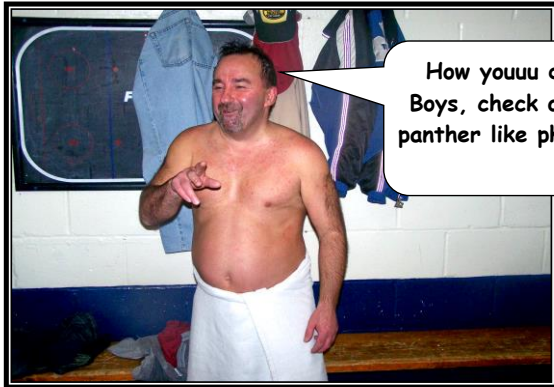

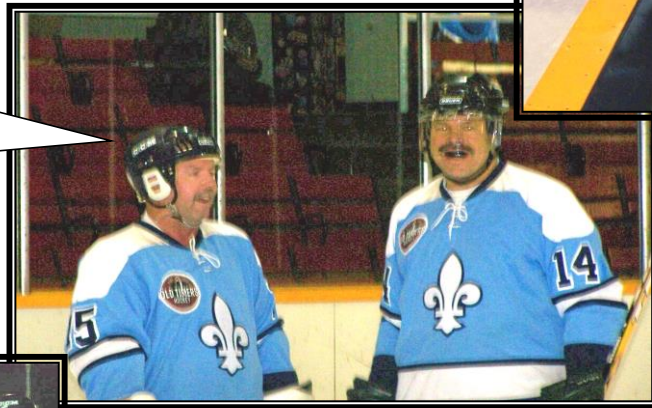

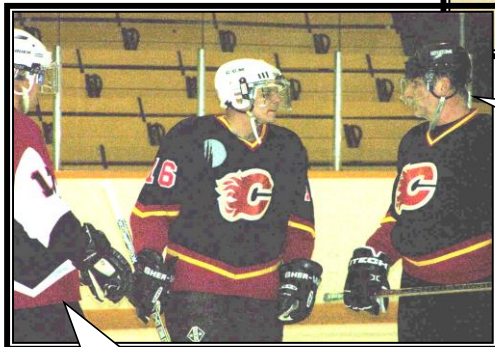
