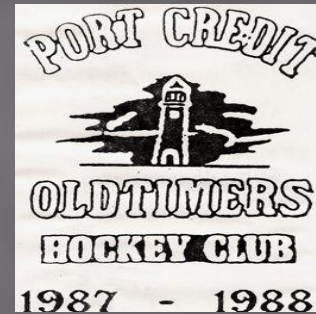


2000-2001 Season in Review
